Rules for Training with Paul Bunyan Dog Training Club

1. All Handlers training with the club must be members of the club.
2. All animals must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of vaccination before any training is allowed. All vaccinations must meet Club's vaccination protocols. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. Dogs must be at least six months old to participate in obedience training and 1 year old for agility training. The maturity of the dog will be taken into consideration and the trainer in charge will give the final judgment.
4. For Acceptance into all Club events, a brief obedience test must be passed proving reasonable control over the dog, e.g. Come, Sit, Stay, Loose Heeling.
5. Dogs not in training or with members are not allowed in the training area.
6. Dogs must be in good health. Any display of illness or injury will cause dismissal from the class at the discretion of the trainer in charge.
7. Except for conformation class, females in estrus (heat) will be excused and asked to leave.
8. Dogs displaying behavior, aggressive or otherwise, that threatens the safety of other dogs, handlers, or spectators will be excused.
9. NO severe discipline, including striking, kicking, or other abuse. 1 warning with handler excused from training on 2nd offense for remainder of season. No refund.
10. Each owner/handler is responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Violators may be fined.
11. Handlers may be of any age, but must be able to understand the training process and control the dog. We suggest that handlers be at least 9 years of age. Final judgment is by the trainer in charge.
12. The club requires the use of appropriate equipment. For example: for obedience, a 6 foot leash of leather or nylon (no chain leashes) and a choke or pinch collar is suggested. For agility, a flat collar with no tags attached, or no collar on the course. Please check with instructor prior to registration.
